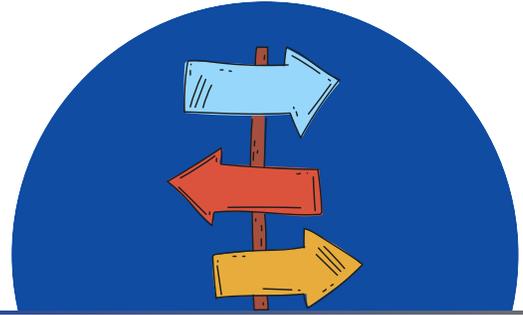


Top 5 Tricks to De-slop Your AI Bot

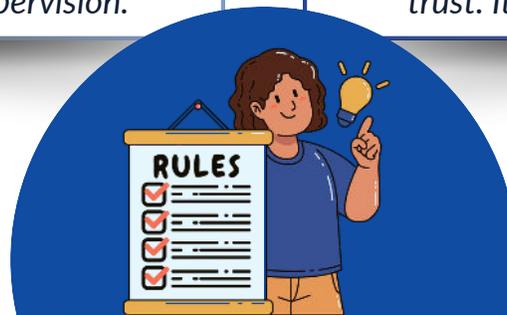

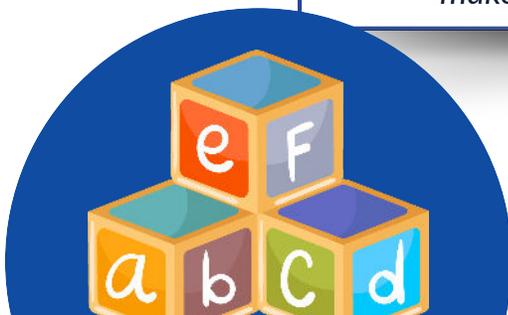
ENVISION 1,000 KINDERGARTENERS
AI is less like an expert and more like an enthusiastic, overconfident 5-year-old. It needs instruction and supervision.



GIVE IT ONE JOB
For example: scheduling. Nothing else. Tight scope improves accuracy, speed, and trust. It also shortens build time.



USE CLEAN, PLAIN-TEXT DATA
AI performs best with .txt files, bulleted lists, and numbered rules. Extra material will make it confused and slow.



S-P-E-L-L EVERYTHING OUT
AI does not have common sense and will guess to fill gaps. Be explicit. If it should never browse online for answers, say so.



PLAN FOR ONGOING REFINEMENT
AI systems improve through use. Task subject-matter experts (not developers) with updating data and rules.
